I Said It Because Yahweh Prophesied It

Yahweh is the only Being who has the power to accurately foretell events thousands of years in advance of the events coming to pass.

Yahweh told Cain that his rebellion would keep him from growing in righteousness, and that he would eventually turn the world to fighting continual wars, vengeance, and retaliation.

Genesis 4:5-7

5 But He did not honor Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.

6 So Yahweh said to Cain: Why are you <u>angry</u>? Why are you downcast?

7 If you do Righteousness, will you not <u>be acceptable</u>? And if you do not do Righteousness, sin *is* crouching at your door. The <u>desire to sin</u> is with you, but <u>you must overcome</u> it!

Verse 7: the desire to sin?

Sin?

I Yahchanan 3:4-12

4 Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the laws; for <u>sin is</u> the transgression of the laws.

- 5 And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him is no sin.
- 6 Whoever abides in Him does not sin; whoever sins, has not seen Him, neither knows Him.
- 7 Little children, <u>let no man deceive you</u>; <u>he who practices</u> <u>righteousness is righteous</u>, just as He is righteous.
- 8 <u>He who practices sin is of the devil</u>, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested; that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- 9 Whoever is begotten of Yahweh does not practice sin; for His seed remains in him; and it is possible for him not to sin, because he has been begotten of Yahweh.
- 10 In this the children of Yahweh and the children of the devil are manifest. Whoever does not practice righteousness is not of Yahweh, and he does not love his neighbor!
- 11 For this is the message that you heard <u>from the beginning</u>, that we should love one another.
- 12 Not as Cain, who was of that evil one, and murdered his brother. And why did he murder his brother? Because <u>his works</u> were evil, and his brother's were righteous.

Back to Genesis 4:6: angry, downcast—his works were evil.

Remember **Genesis 4:7**: the desire to sin must be overcome <u>to be acceptable</u> to Yahweh.

Accepted or acceptable, how?

Compare:

I Yahchanan 3:7

Little children, let no man deceive you; <u>he who practices</u> <u>righteousness</u> is righteous, just as He is righteous.

I Yahchanan 3:4

Whoever commits sin, transgresses also the Laws; for <u>sin is</u> the transgression of the Laws.

Did you notice the word **practice**?

Salvation starts with practicing the fourth commandment.

The Savior said in:

Revelation 22:12-14, KJV

12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward [is] with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

13 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.

14 <u>Blessed [are] they that do his commandments</u>, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

The fourth commandment:

Exodus 20:2-20

- 2 I am Yahweh your Heavenly Father Who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of bondage.
- 3 You shall have no hinder Gods (elohim) at all. They are in opposition against Me.
- 4 You shall not offer yourselves to; *serve or worship*, any God (el, teraph), or any form of anything in heaven above, or on the earth beneath, or in the waters below.
- 5 You shall not bow down to them nor serve them; for I, Yahweh your Father, am a Heavenly Father Who is zealous for My House. The sexual sins of the fathers will be on the children to the third and fourth generation of those who transgress My laws and change them.
- 6 But I will show My love to thousands who love Me by keeping My laws.
- 7 You shall not take the Name of Yahweh your Heavenly Father to bring it to nothing, for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless who brings dishonor upon or profanes His Name.
- 8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it sacred.
- 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
- 10 But the seventh day is the Sabbath of Yahweh your Heavenly Father. Therefore, in it you shall do only the work of Yahweh: you, and your wife, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and your cattle, and the stranger who dwells within your gates.
- 11 For *in* six days Yahweh made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them; and ceased from *this* work on the seventh day. Therefore, <u>Yahweh blessed the Sabbath day</u>, and did righteous works on it.
- 12 Honor your father and your mother, so your days will be long upon the land which Yahweh your Father is giving you.

- 13 You shall not murder.
- 14 You shall not commit adultery.
- 15 You shall not steal.
- 16 You shall not bear false testimony against your neighbor.
- 17 You shall not covet; *lust after*, your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his donkey, nor anything that *belongs to* your neighbor.
- 18 And all the people saw the thunder and lightning, and heard the shofar, and saw the mountain in smoke; and when the people saw *it*, they stood at a distance and trembled.
- 19 Then they said to Mosheh; You speak with us, and we will listen; but do not let Yahweh speak with us, or we will die.
- 20 Mosheh said to the people; Do not fear, for Yahweh has come to test and prove you, so that the reverence for Yahweh will be with you, so that you do not commit sin.

The fourth commandment:

Exodus 20:8-11

- 8 Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it sacred.
- 9 Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
- 10 But the seventh day is the Sabbath of Yahweh your Heavenly Father. Therefore, in it you shall do only the work of Yahweh: you, and your wife, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and your cattle, and the stranger who dwells within your gates.
- 11 For in six days Yahweh made the heavens and the earth, the

sea, and all that is in them; and ceased from *this* work on the seventh day. Therefore, <u>Yahweh</u> blessed the <u>Sabbath</u> day, and did righteous works on it.

Read again from The Book of Yahweh:

Revelation 22:12-14

- 12 And behold, I come quickly, and My Reward *is* with Me, to give every man according as his work will be.
- 13 I am the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.
- 14 Blessed *are* those who keep His Laws, that they will have right to the Tree of Life, and will enter in through the gates into the city.

There are 4,199 religions in this generation. Remember the Savior's words in:

Mattithyah 7:17-19

- 17 Likewise, every Righteous tree brings forth Righteous fruit; but a tree of evil brings forth fruit of iniquity.
- 18 A Righteous tree cannot bring forth fruit of iniquity, nor can a tree of evil bring forth fruits of Righteousness.
- 19 Every tree which does not bring forth Righteous fruit is cut down, and <u>cast into the fire</u>.

Romans 6:16

Do you not know that to whom you yield yourselves as servants to obey, his <u>servants you are whom you obey</u>—whether of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?

Revelation 22:14

Blessed are those who keep His Laws, that they will have right to the Tree of Life, and will enter in through the gates into the city.

So, why don't the 4,199 religions keep the fourth commandment?

The answer: deception.

Revelation 12:9

And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the devil, and Satan, who <u>deceives the whole world</u>. She was cast out into the earth, and her angels were cast out with her.

Yahaqob (James) 2:10-11

10 For whoever keeps the whole law, and yet <u>offends</u> (<u>practices</u> <u>breaking</u>) in <u>one</u> <u>commandment</u>, he is guilty of all.

11 For He Who said: Do not commit adultery, also said: Do not murder. Now if you do not commit adultery, yet you do murder, you have become a transgressor of the laws.

Hebrews 10:26-27

26 For if we <u>sin willfully</u> after we have received the knowledge of the Truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,

27 But a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and <u>fiery</u> <u>indignation</u> which will devour the adversaries.

You should read those Scriptures again and again. They were written to show you <u>the importance of keeping away from you the seven last plagues</u>, which will be the end of sinners.

The End?

The End means just that...the end of sin and sinners. Yahweh shows that the seven last or the end plagues will be the end of sin and sinners.

They have about fourteen months left. The seven last plagues are closing in on them.

Read:

Mattithyah 24:21-22

21 For then will be <u>great tribulation</u>, <u>such as has not come to pass since the beginning</u> of the world to this time—no, nor ever will be.

22 And unless those days were shortened, there would <u>no flesh</u> <u>be saved</u>; but for the elect's sake, those days will be shortened.

Revelation 16:2-21

2 And the first went, and poured out his bowl upon the earth; and there came a noisome and grievous sore upon the <u>men who</u> <u>had the mark of the beast</u>, and *upon* those who worshiped his likeness.

3 And the second malak poured out his bowl upon the sea; and

- it became as the blood of a dead *man*; and every living thing died in the sea.
- 4 And the third malak poured out his bowl upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood.
- 5 And I heard the malak of the waters say: You are righteous, 0 Yahweh, Who is, and was, and will be, because You judge this way.
- 6 For they have shed the blood of Saints and Prophets, so You have given them blood to drink—such is their due.
- 7 And I heard another out of the altar say: Let this be so, Father Yahweh Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments.
- 8 And the fourth malak poured out his bowl upon the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire.
- 9 And men were <u>scorched with great heat</u>, and *they* blasphemed the Name of Yahweh, Whose Law protects the righteous from these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.
- 10 And the fifth malak poured out his bowl upon the Throne of the beast; and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of pain,
- 11 And blasphemed Yahweh in heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their works.
- 12 And the sixth malak poured out his bowl upon the <u>great</u> <u>river Euphrates</u>; and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.
- 13 And I saw three unclean spirits, like frogs, *come* out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet—
- 14 For they are the spirits of demons who perform signs, who go forth to the kings of the whole inhabited earth, to gather

them to the battle of that great day of Yahweh Almighty.

- 15 (Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed *is* he who watches, and keeps his garments, or he will walk naked, and they will see his shame.)
- 16 And He gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew language: HarMegiddo; Armageddon.
- 17 And the seventh malak poured out his bowl into the air; and there came a great voice out of the House of heaven, from the Throne, saying: It is done.
- 18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.
- 19 And it came to pass that the great city divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations, fell. And great Babylon came in remembrance before Yahweh, to give to her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.
- 20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
- 21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, *every hailstone* about the weight of a talent. And men blasphemed Yahweh because of the <u>plague of the hail</u>; for <u>exceedingly great is the plague</u> of it.

Revelation 17:7-9

- 7 And the Messenger said to me: Why are you astonished? I will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carries her, which has the <u>seven heads</u> and ten horns.
- 8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition. And those who dwell on the earth will wonder—whose names were not written in The Book of Life from the foundation of the world—when they

see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

9 And here is the mind which has wisdom: The <u>seven heads are</u> seven hills on which the woman sits.

Verses 7 and **9** show this religion sits on seven hills. That is the Roman Catholic Church.

Her exposure to all the world is prophesied and coming to pass.

II Thessalonians 2:1-12

- 1 Now we plead with you, brothers, concerning the coming of our King, Yahshua Messiah, and our gathering together to Him,
- 2 That you <u>not be soon shaken in mind</u>, nor be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as *if* from us, as that the day of Yahweh is at hand.
- 3 <u>Let no man deceive you</u> by any means; <u>for that day will not</u> <u>come</u>, <u>unless there comes a falling away first</u>, <u>and that servant of sin is revealed</u>: the son of perdition,
- 4 Who is an adversary, and exalts himself above all, declaring himself a god (el), and he is to be worshiped; so that he, as a God (el), sits in the temple of God (beth-el), showing himself to be a God (el).
- 5 Do you not remember that when I was still with you, I told you these things?
- 6 And now you know what is restraining him, so that he may be revealed in his time.
- 7 For the mystery of iniquity is already working, but the One restraining him will continue to restrain him, until he is

made to appear in the midst.

8 And then that lawless one will be revealed, whom Yahshua will remove with the breath of His Mouth, and make powerless with the appearance of His coming—

9 Whose coming is according to the energy of Satan, who works with all power, and signs, and lying wonders,

10 And with all deceivableness of sin in those who are perishing, because they did not receive the love of the Truth, that they might be saved.

11 And for this reason, <u>Yahweh will allow strong delusions to</u> <u>come</u> upon them, that they would believe the deception,

12 In order that all those may be <u>judged</u> as not having <u>believed</u> the <u>truth</u>, but as having delighted in sin.
